



**REPORT ON

Visual Effects:

Visual Effects is abbreviated as VFX. There are the special effects that are applied post-production to YouTube Videos, Advertisements, Music Videos, Movies and Games to make them more presentable.

Game Designing:

It refers to the application of creativity of a designer to create a game for leisure or instructional reasons. It is a part of the video game production. To enable interface with other characters, objects or users which includes producing engaging characters, storylines, rules, objectives and challenges.

All the faculties Prof. Sanjay Gamare, Dr. Shubhangi Kadam, Dr. Sanjay Khaire, Prof. Poonam Kadam and Prof. Pooja Khude of Department of Commerce were present in the visit. 72 students participated in this visit.
